

## Pocatello Aerie Organized In 1901



Pocatello Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie No. 119 was organized February 9, 1901. First lodge hall was located in a one story building located on the present site of the Whitman Hotel. Later on the lodge built the two story building occuped by the Lynn Hospital.

The first grand worthy president was W. S. Hopson.

About 1902 the Eagles organized the first municipal band for Pocatello. This was fostered and organized by W. A. Samms, then the city engineer.

Among the charter members were Edward Stein, first mayor of Pocatello; J. B. Joseph, the first fire chief; James H. Brady, Thomas Coffin, D. Worth Clark, Glen Taylor. Two of the oldest charter members still living are Issac Troupe, 740 Noth Main and August Radamacher, 422 East Terry. The oldest living Past Worthy President is W. R. Blalock of 228 North Fifth Avenue.

One of the main objectives of the Eagles is the old age pension law.

The Eagles Club is the nation's largest benefit paying fraternity with more than a million members. The objectives of the order include extension of social security, youth guidance programs, child health and aid for the handicapped.
